



Job Title: Cell Tower Foreman
Reports To: Construction Manager

The Foreman is responsible for supervising job site technicians and performing construction duties on a daily basis in order to meet customer deadlines while enforcing all EasTower and OSHA safety practices.

Key Responsibilities:

- Complete work in a timely and efficient manner by planning, prioritizing and mobilizing staff, materials in order to meet customer schedule
- Identify early, all materials and other resources needed to complete project on schedule
- Reading, interpreting alarm reports and troubleshooting problems within the wireless network with minimal guidance
- Troubleshooting knowledge for clearing alarms associated with AT&T
- Experience with AT&T video audits
- Ability to identify out of scope work
- Finalize all inspections to close project. Ability to capture/upload site photographs, forms, etc.
- Responsible for submitting all daily and weekly required paperwork: Daily Construction Log (DCL), Job Safety Hazard (JSH), weekly safety topics, crane/heavy machinery forms, etc.
- Expert in reading Construction Documents, blueprints, RFD's, etc.
- Ability to set direction and organize daily work assignments to technician to ensure tasks assigned are completed in a timely, high quality and safe manner
- Maintain and enforce all EasTower and OSHA safety practices, perform daily jobsite safety inspections on equipment prior to operation. Immediately stops work when unsafe work practices or conditions exist
- Must be able to work overtime to include weekends and evening hours
- Perform other related duties as assigned

Job Requirements:

- At least 2 years of supervisory/management experience in wireless site construction
- A minimum of 5 years of cell tower climbing experience
- Willingness to travel within the state of Florida
- Required to work at heights (up to 400 ft) installing telecom equipment/materials on towers, monopoles, roof tops, etc. including mounts, radios and antennas
- Interprets various documents (blueprints, diagrams, manufacturer specifications) to ensure proper installation of antenna systems using technical expertise and knowledge
- Expert knowledge in system testing – PIM, ANRITSU Fiber, RET, etc.
- Advanced understanding of rigging
- Ensure safety practices are observed by all technicians
- Obtain US driver's license
- Ability to drive truck pulling a 28 ft trailer
- Proficient in the English language (speaking, reading and writing)
- Ability to pass National Wireless Safety Alliance (NWSA) Tower Climber exam

Qualifications:

- All required certifications including OSHA 30, RF Awareness, 1st Aid/CPR, Bloodborne Pathogen, GHS & Hazard Communication, Heat Stress, Capstan/Hoist, Lockout/Tagout, Crane Spotter/Signal and others
- Competent Climber and Rescue, Rigging Safety certificates required
- NWSA certificate
- High energy, strong decision-making abilities and good interpersonal skills are keys for success
- Reliable and a good work ethic

Education and/or Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Construction Management or equivalent work experience
- 5+ years of experience completing various tower installations including but not limited to stacking, modifications, fiber, roof tops and Line and Antenna (L&A)

Computer Skills:

- Proficient computer skills including MS Office

Physical Demands:

- Ability to walk, stand, bend and climb up to 400 feet
- Ability to work on job site in remote location for extended periods of time
- Ability to hear, understand and respond appropriately to verbal requests made in person and over the telephone
- Regularly required to stand for long hours, walk in mud and rain, use hands to touch or feel, reach with hands and arms, talk and hear
- Routinely lift and/or move up, but not limited to 50 pounds includes body weight, equipment and tools
- Work weekends and odd hours as required
- Routinely climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crawl and lift
- Work inside and outdoors including all weather conditions such as wet, hot, cold and freezing
- Ability to travel extensively throughout Florida
